#### **CELEBRATING THE SAINTS**



**BL. JOHN FRANCIS BURTE AND** <u>COMPANIONS (d. 1792 and 1794)</u>, were victims of the French Revolution. The law of 1790 made the Catholic Church subordinate to the French government. All clergy were required to take a loyalty oath that amounted to a denial of the faith.

JOHN FRANCIS BURTE, a Franciscan Friar. APOLLINARIS OF POSAT, a Capuchin Franciscan. SEVERIN GIRAULT, a Chaplain and member of the Third Order Regular. With 182 Bishops, Religious and Diocesan Priests who also refused to take the oath, all were martyred in Paris in 1792.

JOHN BAPTIST TRIQUERIE, a Conventual Franciscan, and 13 Diocesan Priests, also refused and were martyred in 1794.
